Significant Accounting policies and Notes on Accounts

A) Significant Accounting Policies

1. General:

- a) The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India and the Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and the relevant provision of the Companies Act, 1956 as adopted consistently by the Company.
- b) Accounting policies not specifically referred to are in consonance with the generally accepted accounting principles followed by the Company.
- c) Revenue and Expenses are being accounted for on Mercantile Basis.

2. Basis of Accounting:

All the Income and Expenditures are recognized on Accrual Basis except Rates & Taxes that is accounted for on Cash Basis.

3. Investments:

Investments being long terms and non trade investment are valued at cost and provisions for diminution, if any other than temporary is made to recognize decline in the value of investments on the basis of market/break up value as applicable.

B) Notes on Accounts:

- 1. Amalgamation of Simon Vanijya Pvt. Ltd and Swagath Vanijya Pvt. Ltd with the Company.
 - a) Pursuant to the scheme of Amalgamation erstwhile Simon Vanijya Pvt. Ltd and Swagath Vanijya Pvt. Ltd with the Company, w.e.f. 1st April, 2010 as approved by the Hon'ble High Court of Kolkata vide order dated 11th day of July, 2011. In terms of the said scheme all the Assets & Liabilities of the erstwhile Transferor Companies were transferred to and vested in the Company w.e.f 1st April, 2010 at their respective book value. The effect for the same have been given in these Accounts accordingly and in consonance with Accounting Policies followed by the Transferee Company.



- b) All the Assets & Liabilities of Transferor Companies have been recorded in these accounts at their respective book values. Excess of Assets taken over and above the Liabilities and Share Capital issued to the shareholders of erstwhile transferor companies has been credited to Securities Premium Account in terms of Scheme as approved by the Hon' able High court of Kolkata.
- c) Pursuant to scheme as referred to in (a) above 10,51,400 Equity Shares of Rs. 10/- is to be issued to the shareholders of erstwhile Simon Vanijya Pvt. Ltd and Swagath Vanijya Pvt. Ltd, Pending Allotment for the same has been credited to Share Capital Suspense Account
- d) As per order of Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata dated 11.07.2011 the Authorized Share Capital of Transferor Companies have been amalgamated with the company and increased from Rs.150 lacs to Rs.184 lacs.
- e) 173,400 Equity Shares of Rs. 10/- each were cancelled in respect to Scheme of Amalgamation as read in 1 (a) above.
- 2. During the year the company has transferred Rs.2,654.68/- (P.Y.Rs.1160/-) to Special Reserve Account in accordance with 45IC of RBI Act, 1934.
- 3. During the year the company has made a provision of Rs.38,481.59/- on Standard Assets as per NBFC Prudential Norms under notification number DNBS.222 CGM(US)2011 and DNBS.223 CGM(US)2011 dated January,17,2011
- 4. The company having Deferred Tax Assets due to carry forward losses as per AS-22, the same has not been recognized in the accounts as a matter of prudence.
- 5. In the opinion of the Board the Current Assets, Loans & Advances have realization value in the ordinary course of business at least equal to which they are stated in Balance Sheet.
- 6. The Outstanding balance of Sundry Creditors, Deposits and Advances are subject to confirmation and reconciliation, if any.
- 7. The company has no related party transaction during the year.
- 8. The company has only one segment i.e. Finance and Investment Activities hence no segment reporting is given as required under AS-17 issued by ICAI.

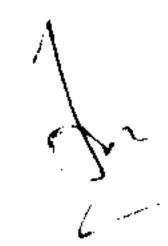
